ESSAY

Clearly explain how this scholarship will assist you in achieving your career goals.

Demonstrate your talent by writing about any special interests or special circumstances that you may wish the selection committee to consider. Since you are applying for a Scholarship that requires a demonstrated financial need, prior employment, family responsibilities, evidence of leadership, community service, etc, should be addressed specifically in your essay.

ESSAY FORMAT: Use 8 ½” x 11” white paper; type or use a computer. Limit the essay to one or two pages. Use your NAME and ESSAY as the title. **Double-space** the body of your essay and use 1” margin all around. (No extra documents such as pictures, resume, etc. will be accepted.)

Support Material

Be sure to include at least two, but no more than three, letters of recommendation with your application. At least one letter should be from one of your current teachers or instructors. Letters of recommendation may be sent directly from the author to the Selection Committee Chairman, Ruffed Grouse Society, P.O. Box 111, Hampden, ME 04444.

All letters must be received by the deadline date. Late references will not be considered.
