The Ruffed Grouse society of Maine is pleased to offer a \$3,000 scholarship to a deserving student who will be starting their education in one of the following areas of study: wildlife conservation, conservation law enforcement, forest management, or a related field that is supportive of the broad goals of the Ruffed Grouse Society at both the regional and national level. Applicants must intend to become a practitioner in one of the above mentioned fields, preferably in the state of Maine.

Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Maine.
- Must have graduated from a Maine secondary school.
- Must enroll in an approved undergraduate program for the 2011 fall semester.

To apply for this scholarship, please complete an application. In addition, a copy of your high school transcript for all courses completed should be included with the application.

Telephone interviews may be conducted so make sure that you include an active telephone number and/ or e-mail address on your application.

The deadline for receipt of applications is Friday, April 1, 2011

Note: Recipients will not receive this scholarship until the committee receives a transcript of the winning applicant's first semester grades. The transcript must reflect an earned Grade Point Average of 3.0 (based upon a 4.0 scale). In addition, the recipient must be eligible and registered for the following semester.
